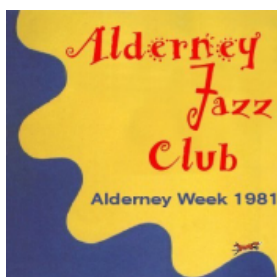

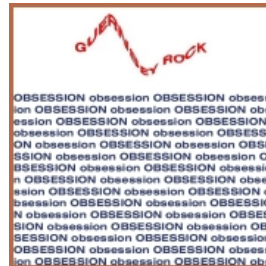
The Last Night Celebration of one of Guernsey's "Iconic" Rock Groups

The Little Theatre (also a place to remember) - September 10th, 1967

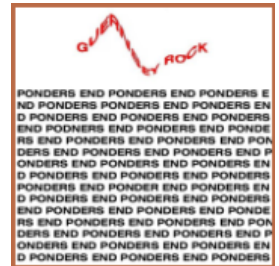
